

ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY ACT 2000 VARIATION OF ELECTRICITY RETAIL LICENCE

MTA Energy Pty Limited ACN 622 895 274

SUMMARY

Pursuant to section 29(1)(b) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (El Act), the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has varied the licence granted to MTA Energy Pty Limited (ACN 622 895 274) (MTA Energy) to sell electricity to customers in Victoria.

BACKGROUND

On 10 February 2021, MTA Energy was first granted its electricity retail licence.

On 31 May 2024, MTA Energy requested the commission vary clause 9.1 of its licence to include the sale of electricity to small business customers. The preceding version of clause 9.1 indicated that MTA Energy is authorised to sell electricity to medium business customers and large business customers only.

On 16 September 2024, MTA Energy agreed to the commission making amendments of a consequential nature to clause 1.1 of the licence to reflect the variation to clause 9.1.

Additionally, on 16 September 2024, MTA Energy also agreed for the commission to change the address for service of notices to MTA Energy under clause 2.1 of the licence.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act provides that a licence may be varied by agreement between the commission and the licensee.

DECISION

In accordance with section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act, the commission has decided to vary the licence by agreement with MTA Energy to vary clauses 1.1, 2.1 and 9.1 of the licence. The licensee consented to these variations.
