VARIATION OF AN ELECTRICITY RETAIL LICENCE**

RECORD OF DECISION

7 January 2025

SUMMARY

Pursuant to the provisions of section 29(1) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (EI Act) the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has varied the licence of Enel Energy Australia Pty Ltd (ACN 632 774 255) (Enel Energy) to sell electricity by retail in Victoria.

BACKGROUND

On 24 November 2021, Enel Energy was first granted an electricity retail licence.

On 9 December 2024, Enel Energy notified the commission of a change of its legal name to Potentia Energy Retail Pty Ltd (ACN 632 774 255) and change of address for service of notices.

On 17 December 2024, Enel Energy agreed to the variations to its licence.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act provides that a licence may be varied by agreement between the commission and the licensee.

DECISION

In accordance with section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act and having regard to the commission's objectives under the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 and the EI Act, the delegate of the commission has decided to vary the licence by agreement to change the legal name of the licensee from Enel Energy Australia Pty Ltd (ACN 632 774 255) to Potentia Energy Retail Pty Ltd (ACN 632 774 255) and change the licensee's address for service of notices.
